The Emergency Food Assistance Program

Income eligible individuals and families can receive food at no cost through **The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP)**. This program is also known as the **Commodity Program**.

What is TEFAP?

- ⇒ A federally funded program which helps supplement the diets of low-income individuals and families by providing a monthly supply of food at no cost.
- ⇒ Quality USDA (United States Department of Agriculture) products.
- ⇒ Food is distributed once per month through Macomb County distribution sites.

Do I Qualify?

- ⇒ To qualify your household income must be below 200% of the Federal income guidelines (see example):

2	\$32,480
3	\$40,840
4	\$49,200
5	\$57,560
6	\$65,920
