The MOC is a 40-foot doctor's office on wheels that transports medical staff and equipment to local sites to provide a wide-range of healthcare, such as, screenings, immunizations, treatment of chronic diseases like diabetes and providing initial care for long-term health issues such as cancer. All medical treatment, including prescription medications, is provided at no cost to the patient.
