The Emergency Food Assistance Program



What is TEFAP?

- ⇒ A federal program that helps supplement the diets of low-income individuals and families, including the elderly, by providing them with emergency food and nutrition assistance at no cost.
- ⇒ Quality USDA (United States Department of Agriculture) products.
- ⇒ Food is distributed once per month through Macomb County distribution sites.

Do I Qualify?

- ⇒ To qualify your household income must be below the Federal income guidelines (see example):

1	\$24,980
2	\$33,820
3	\$42,660
4	\$51,500
